

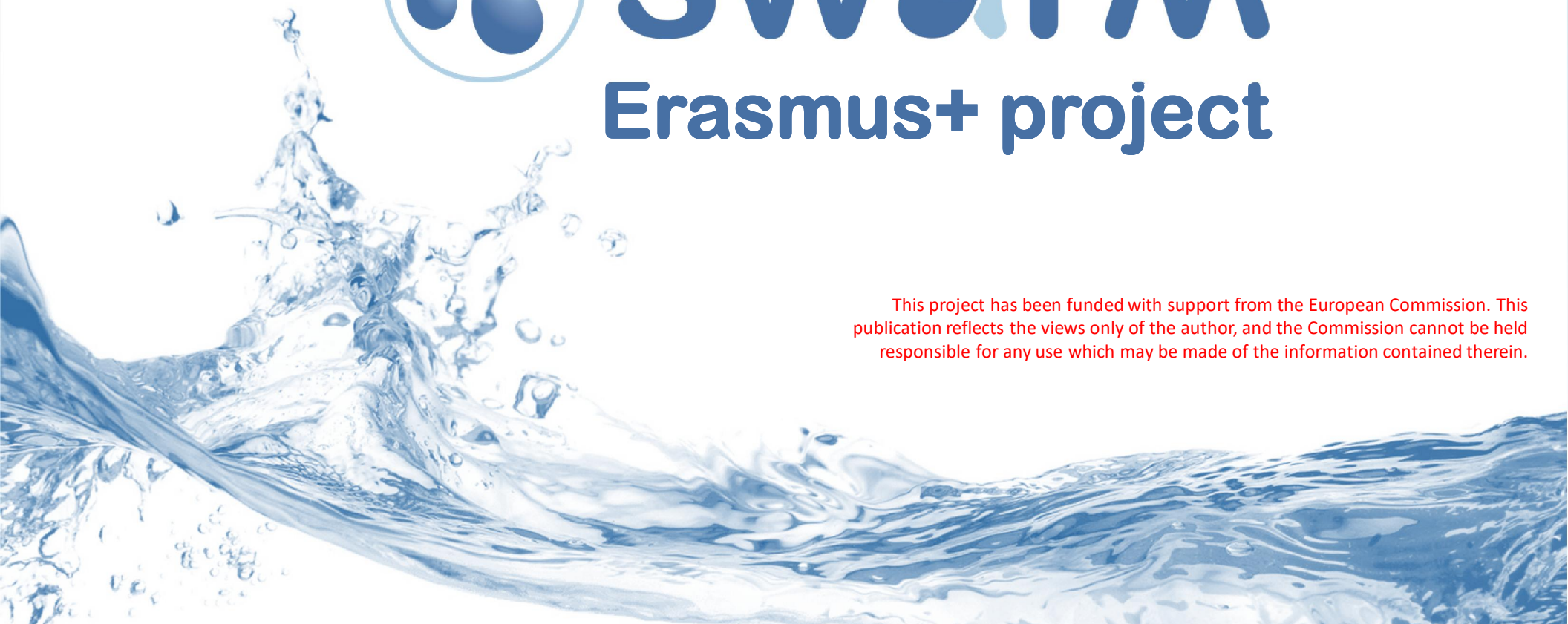

- **Develop and implement LLL courses for the water sector** in line with EU Water Framework Directive

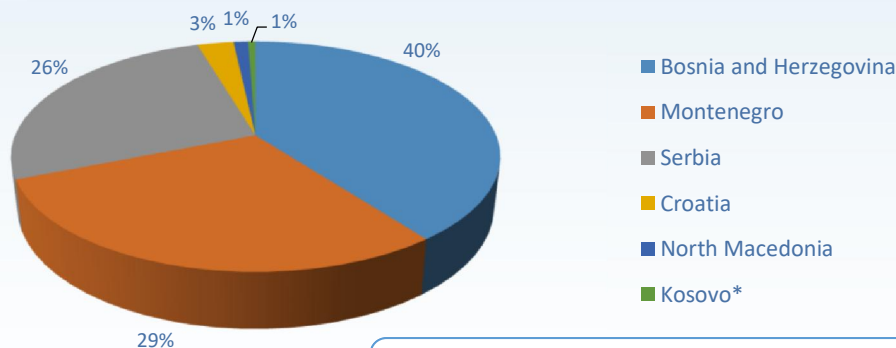
