of the University's integrative functions

Department for International Cooperation provides strategic support to the University of Kragujevac management in order to develop and improve the University's internationalization strategy.

At the same time the Department carries out administrative activities - provides information regarding the opportunities for international



cooperation, coordinates and implements international programs in the field of mobility, research and education, providing support to the faculties in the preparation of project proposals and administration of projects, collects data and prepares applications for university ranking lists, coordinates signing and implementation of bilateral agreements, organizes information days and workshops, international conferences and meetings, visits of foreign delegations and officials, as well as other activities aimed at promoting the value of international cooperation among the University's students and staff.





Erasmus+ programme

The new Erasmus+ programme runs from 2021-2027 and the projected budget for this seven-year period amounts to 26 billion euros.





With the support of the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union

The Republic of Serbia has been participating in the program as a full member since the Call for proposals for 2019.

The Erasmus+ programme consists of three key activities – KA1 (mobility projects), KA2 (institutional cooperation projects for innovation and exchange of good practices) and KA3 (projects to support education policy development and reforms) - Jean Monnet actions are separate actions in new Erasmus.

University of Kragujevac was approved the renewal of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education - ECHE 2021-2027.



Student Mobility

UNIKG students may carry out the following types of mobilities: 1. study period abroad,

- 2. traineeship (work placement, internship) abroad,
- 3. combined mobilities for studies and traineeship,

4. blended intensive programmes.

Staff Mobility

UNIKG academic and non-academic staff may apply for:

- 1. teaching period abroad,
- 2. training period abroad.



- within KA131 mobility projects with Programme Countries (Erasmus IIAs have been signed with over 100 HEIs),
- within KA171 mobility projects with Partner Countries (China, Australia, Algeria, Tunisia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina,

Dominican Republic, Georgia, Israel, Jordan, Uzbekistan).
